You are cordially invited to join us at our inaugural conversation about the Ground Security initiative at the University of Regina.

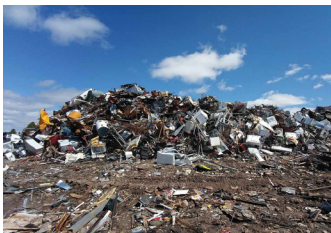
During the day, we will identify issues of importance and challenges facing infrastructure in and on the ground.
